

Harlequin Felted Hat

Materials:

Yarn: 3 Skeins Brown Sheep Prairie Silk PS150 Obsidian, 1-3/4 oz/50 g, 88 yds/80.5 m
1 Skein Brown Sheep Handpainted Originals HP85 Cream Puff, 1-3/4 oz/50 g, 88 yds/80.5 m

Needles: 11 US/8 mm circular

11 US/8 mm set of double point needles

Gauge: 6 stitches and 8 rows = 2"/5 cm over stockinette stitch

Darning needle

Finished Dimensions:

20"/50.8 cm circumference

Directions:

With 11 US/8 mm circular needles and Brown Sheep Prairie Silk Obsidian, cast on 120 stitches. Join being careful not to twist the stitches and placing a marker at the beginning stitch.

Rows 1 through 20: Knit to end of each round.

Row 21: Knit 3 in Obsidian, then work pattern – repeat this pattern so there are 13 diamonds. Be sure to knit 3 prior to each row in the chart – the knit 3 allows for the back to be located properly. Also, carry non-stitching yarn very loosely across the back – it will felt into the hat when completed.

There should be 13 "diamonds" circling the entire hat when the chart is completed. When you have finished the chart you have completed using Cream Puff. Row 36: Knit for 14 rounds in Brown Sheep Prairie Silk in Obsidian.
