Beading Submission Checklist

Color images of finished project

(This can be the beaded item photographed alone or on a model, and/or a detail of the beads or stitches.)

Images can be submitted in the following formats:

A) High-quality, high-resolution, digital images on CD or via e-mail

Digital images need to be no less than 300 dpi, at least 4"x 6" finished size, and normal pixellation (web quality images of 72 dpi **cannot** be accepted). Images can be in jpg or tif format in appropriate resolution.

B) High-quality slide(s), transparencies, or photograph(s)

Please note: Laser printouts of images will not yield a high enough quality image for publication. Original photography will be returned upon request.

C) Send a finished beading project to be photographed

If you do not feel confident that you can send an image that is appropriate quality, you can send finished beading projects to be professionally photographed by Accord Publishing. Please include a self-addressed return envelope with appropriate postage to ensure prompt return of materials.

Full pattern instructions, on CD, via e-mail, or hardcopy

Instructions should include materials needed, stitches required (i.e. herringbone, peyote, etc.), and full beading instructions.

Step-by-step figures, photos, or diagrams (if applicable)

Step-by-step figures, photos, or diagrams should be in tif, jpg or eps format at no less than 300 dpi. Please name as such: 01_Fig_ProjectName, 02_Fig_ProjectName, 03_Fig_ProjectName, etc.
