Leaves Turning Cowl

As the leaves start turning and the air gets nippy, a light but wooly cowl is a perfect way to add a little warmth, color, and sass to your day.

Skill Level: Easy

Finished Dimensions: Approx 14" (35.5 cm) wide;
23" (58.5 cm) circumference

Yarn: Berroco Keltic, a 50% wool, 40% acrylic, and 10% rayon heavy worsted weight yarn packaged in 1.75 oz/50 g balls containing 103 yds/95 m: 2 balls

Needles: 16" (40 cm) circular needle 8 mm/U.S. 11

Other Materials: Stitch marker, tapestry needle

Gauge: Approx 10 sts and 18 rows = 4" (10 cm) in St st

To save time, please check your gauge.



DIRECTIONS:

Very loosely cast on 50 sts.

Join to begin working in rnd, being careful not to twist. Pm to mark beg of rnd.

Rnds 1–8: K

Pattern Stitch

Rnd 1: *K3, k2tog, rep from *. (40 sts)

Rnd 2: *K2tog, yo, rep from *.

Rnd 3: K.

Rep Pattern Stitch Rnds **2 and 3** until piece measures approx 12" (30.5 cm) from cast-on edge, ending with a Rnd 3.

Next Rnd: *K4, m1, rep from *. (50 sts)

Knit 7 rnds.

Very loosely bind off all sts. Weave in all ends, and enjoy your cozy cowl!
